

4	Nut, M8	2


1 Remove the right hand upper RSU mount fixing (1) and washer (2). Discard and replace the fixing if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition. Retain the washer for reuse.



WARNING: Do not move the motorcycle after removing the fixing.



6mm hexagonal bit and ratchet




Fitment without Rear Rack 1990536

2 Align the right hand pannier rail upper mount (1) and the washer removed in step 1 (2) with the upper RSU mount (3). Fit the M8 x 20mm fixing (4) to secure the pannier rail to the motorcycle frame, as shown.

Do not fully tighten the fixing at this stage.



5mm hexagonal bit and ratchet




3 Align the pannier rail lower mount (1) with the silencer mount plate (2). Fit the M8 x 20mm fixing (3) and nut (4) to secure the pannier rail, as shown.

Tighten the upper fixing to **22Nm.** Tighten the lower fixing (3) to **15Nm**.



5mm hexagonal bit and torque wrench




4 Repeat steps 1 and 2 on the left hand side of the motorcycle for the left hand pannier rail.

For motorcycles with a saree guard fitted

Remove the fixing (1) and nut from the pillion footrest hanger. Retain for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.



12mm socket and ratchet




5 Align the pannier rail lower mount (1) with the silencer mount plate (2). Fit the M8 x 20mm fixing (3) and nut (4) to secure the pannier rail and saree guard (where applicable).

Tighten the upper fixing to **22Nm.** Tighten the lower fixing (3) to **15Nm.**



5mm hexagonal bit and torque wrench



Fitment with Rear Rack 1990536

Note: Rear Rack must be fitted first. See rear rack fitting instructions.

6 Remove the right hand upper RSU mount fixing (1). Discard and replace the fixing if the motorcycle is to be returned to the rear rack only condition.



WARNING: Do not move the motorcycle after removing the fixing.




6mm hexagonal bit and ratchet

7 Align the pannier rail upper mount (1) with the rear rack (2) and upper RSU mount (3). Fit the M8 x 30mm fixing (4) from the rear rack kit to secure the pannier rail upper mount to the motorcycle frame, as shown.

Do not fully tighten the fixing at this stage.



5mm hexagonal bit and ratchet




8 Align the pannier rail lower mount (1) with the spacer (2) from the rear rack kit to the bracket on the motorcycle frame (3). Fit the M8 x 30mm fixing (4) from the rear rack kit and M8 nut (5) to secure the pannier rail lower mount, as shown.

Tighten the upper fixing to **22Nm.** Tighten the lower fixing (4) to **15Nm**.



5mm hexagonal bit and torque wrench




9 Repeat steps 6 and 7 on the left hand side of the motorcycle for the left hand pannier rail.

For motorcycles with a saree guard fitted

Remove the fixing (1) and nut from the pillion footrest hanger. Retain for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.



12mm socket and ratchet




10 Align the pannier rail lower mount (1) with the spacer (2) from the rear rack kit to the bracket on the motorcycle frame (3). Fit the M8 x 30mm fixing (4) from the rear rack kit and M8 nut to secure the pannier rail and saree guard (where applicable).

Tighten the upper fixing to **22Nm.** Tighten the lower fixing (4) to **15Nm.**



5mm hexagonal bit and torque wrench
