


CAUTION: Care should be taken when fitting any accessory kit. Incorrect handling kit components or the use of incorrect tools could lead to component or motorcycle damage.




Item	Description	Qty
1	Backrest Pad	1
2	Backrest mount, left hand	1
3	Backrest mount, right hand	1
4	Fixing, M8 x 20mm	2


1 While supporting the original backrest assembly (1), remove the backrest mount fixings (2), right hand side shown. Remove the backrest assembly from the motorcycle. Retain the original backrest assembly for reuse if the accessory backrest assembly is removed. Retain the fixings for reuse.




2 Position the accessory backrest pad (1) onto the right hand backrest mount (2) from the kit in the orientation shown and align the fixing positions. Fit one of the M8 x 20mm fixings (3) from the kit, do not fully tighten the fixing at this stage.



3 Position the left hand backrest mount (1) from the kit on the accessory backrest pad (2) in the orientation shown and align the fixing positions. Fit the M8 x 20mm fixing (3), do not fully tighten the fixing at this stage.



4 Fit the backrest assembly (1) to the motorcycle and align the backrest mounts with the fixing positions on the motorcycle frame. Fit the original fixings (2), right hand side shown. Do not fully tighten the fixings at this stage.



5 Tighten the m8 x 20mm backrest pad fixings to **25Nm**. Tighten the backrest mount fixings to **25Nm**.
